- the Allies of Oquaga, living historians who portray the 18th century lifestyle of the Iroquois Nation
- sales booths, including traditional crafts, building arts, toys, local farm produce, and regionally recognized food products; tools, antiques and collectibles from 19th and early 20th c. rural life, regional authors & booksellers
- displays and programs by regional historical societies, museums and educational not-for-profits
- entertainment and fun, to include a square dance, horseshoe competition, story telling, history mystery games; demonstrations & interactive play with old toys and games; old engines, vehicles and farm machinery
